1, 2, 3, 4, 5

Four paces backwards
1, 2, 3, 4

Cannon

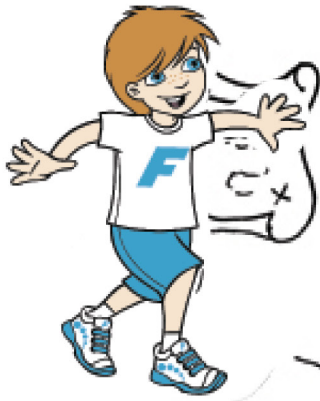
